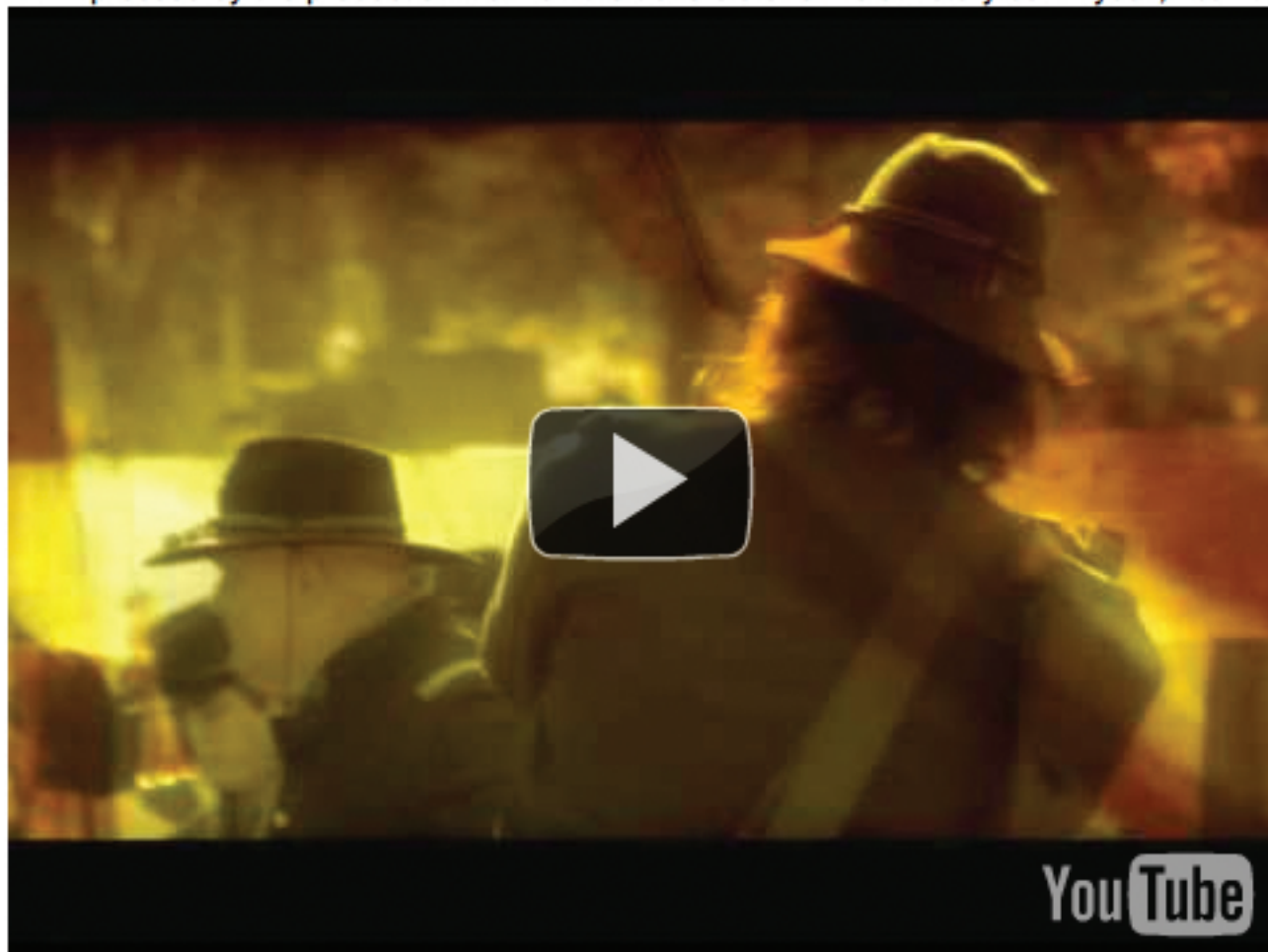
This week, our guest is a multi-talented history buff who turned his family history into an acclaimed book and now a documentary.
